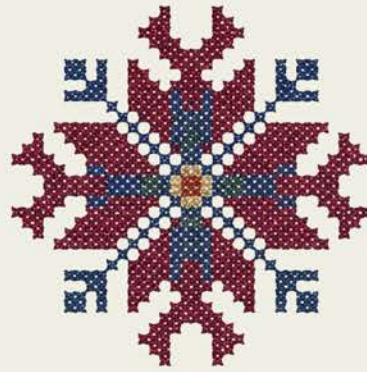

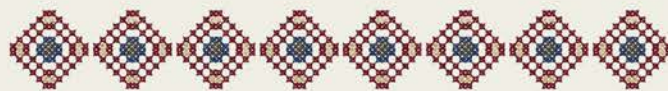
The General Manager's Message

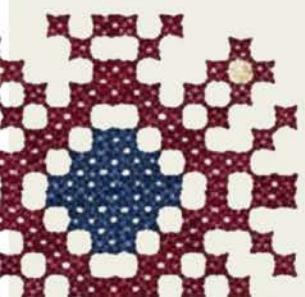

We Remain Active

In partnership with the Jusur National Women’s Forum, we convened our annual conference under the title **“We Remain Active: Community Solidarity in the Face of Erasure.”** Held in the historic Nazareth Market, the conference brought together more than 150 activists and organizers. It addressed policies of erasure manifested through home demolitions, forced displacement, and the targeting of culture, language, and the landscape. The conference included interactive workshops on the challenges facing feminist movements, femicide and house demolitions as part of the system of erasure, and political detention as a tool of repression.

16 Days Campaign: “We’re Still Here”

Under the slogan #Still_Here, the campaign linked gender-based violence to the broader system of erasure within its political and economic contexts. Activities included field-based workshops and meetings, alongside a media presence (analytical posts, videos, and live testimonies) that highlighted resistance mechanisms such as community solidarity and mutual support.

Empowerment & Solidarity Economy

“Yalla ‘al-Wad”: As part of the 16 Days campaign, we organized a bazaar in Wadi Nisnas (Haifa), featuring 15 stalls for women’s products, a barter stall, recycling and urban agriculture initiatives, artistic murals, and musical activities for children.

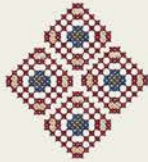


An awareness campaign on financial hardship and the impact of war on women.



Support & Emergency Hotline

The unit provided a comprehensive response in 595 cases, including legal and psychological support, as well as protection plans.



69% of the callers are between 26 and 45 years old.



78% of perpetrators were known to the women.



71% of assaults occurred in private spaces (homes and workplaces).

- The use of organized crime "services" to deprive women of their rights in personal status cases.



Specialized activities of the support unit

- Launched awareness campaigns against harassment in universities, institutions, and the medical sector
- Held study days in three Arab local authorities to raise awareness on combating sexual harassment in the workplace
- Trained a new cohort of volunteers to receive referrals via the hotline



Combating Male Violence & Femicide

We documented the killing of **23 women** from our community in 2025 (representing 60–63% of murder victims despite being only 20% of the population), with a very low case resolution rate (less than 20%).



Our efforts focused on:



Amplifying victims' voices in the media and demanding institutional accountability.



Specialized workshops to support families and hold the system accountable.



Turning the issue of femicide and male violence into an urgent community matter, engaging influential men in the struggle. From this approach, the project **“My Family’s Safety Begins with Me”** was launched in cooperation with the Nadia Center in Rahat.



Community Organizing – Jusur Forum

The forum continued to bridge feminist vision with local communities through



Active participation in the annual conference and the 16 Days campaign.



Intensive activity by local groups in towns including **Jadeidi-Makr, Tallet 'Ara, Deir Hanna, Nazareth, Yafa an-Naseriyye, Arraba, Sakhnin, and others**. Activities included psychosocial support workshops, community dialogues, solidarity visits to victims' families, and protests to strengthen resilience and social solidarity.



In response to the repercussions of war and its impact on women, Kayan utilized specialists to provide psychosocial support to local groups, focusing on psychological fortification and the ability to confront and remain steadfast.



Specific activities focused on reviving Palestinian collective memory and affirming women's historical role, linking this to the axis of violence and its impact on society.



New: Launch of a women's leadership group in Haifa, which contributed to the "Yalla 'al-Wad" bazaar and receives ongoing training in feminist concepts and community organizing.

Awareness & Building the Future



Awareness workshops in schools and youth groups on feminism and forms of violence.



Establishment of a new youth group trained on gender and identity.



Strong media presence through ten interviews on violence, representation, and women's conditions during the war.



Strengthening local and international partnerships, hosting diplomatic delegations, and strategic planning for expansion.

We Did Not Forget Gaza

Despite repression and political persecution, Kayan clearly expressed its rejection of genocide and complicity in it through posts and statements highlighting the suffering of women in Gaza, a special statement on International Women's Day and Mother's Day, and a joint statement with Palestinian civil society organizations calling for an end to the genocide and violations inside Israel. Kayan also organized panels on freedom of expression and protection from persecution, and provided direct legal guidance and support to dozens of cases, including representation in unfair dismissal cases related to expression during the war.



Conclusion

The year 2025 was a harsh test that confirmed that rooted collective steadfastness is capable of confronting systems of violence and erasure. Kayan remains committed to standing with the most marginalized women and struggling for a safe .and just society
